### DRAFT DAY APPROACHES

This Saturday, February the 10th, will be the first ever BRASSBALL Rookie Draft. I hope all of you have had a chance to do some homework. Remember, your roster may not exceed 40 players who are carded, or have ever had a card. Further, your roster may not exceed 5 amateurs during or immediately after the draft.

Unfortunately, unexpected business will prevent Jim Klugh from serving as draft conductor this year. As a result, I will be handling the draft. **PLEASE MAKE A NOTE OF THIS!! The draft will begin at NOON, (eastern time) February 10.** Unless I have heard otherwise, I will assume all of you will be reachable via telephone at the number listed in the league directory, enclosed with this newsletter. David Caddell will not be able to participate, and Charles Kirkwood will be drafting via list for him.

Draft day goes like this: (if you didn't know) When it is your pick, I will ring you once. You then call me back to make your pick. Please be by your phone so as not to miss the single ring. I would hate to have someone lose a pick this way. All of you should be prepared to make update calls during the draft, so keep your directory handy.

### **NEW OWNER ENTERS THE LEAGUE**

Welcome to Rick Matson. He is the new owner of a shiny new BRASSball franchise. Mike O'Connor and Bruce Julin are no longer league members. In the best interests of this league, I excused each of them from any further BRASSball duties. I know that Rick, (who applied a bit too late when the league first started), will be a welcome addition to BRASSball. His team will be known as the South Bend Golden Domers. Gee, might Rick be a fan of the Fighting Irish?

Because the old Poway franchise was in such disarray, I decided to pool it with the old Santa Monica

franchise, and have Rick redraft from that player group. Since I could not find a suitable second owner in time for the dispersal draft (as I wanted this done prior to the Rookie Draft), I drafted for the second team. So what we have is a team without an owner. A ship without a captain. A prison without a warden. A (gosh, I'm in a groove here!) pig without slop. A.....had enough? Anyway, if anyone knows of a hard-core PBMer responsible enough for this league, let me know. We have a team waiting. (known as Team X, for now) I am, as you read this, trying to have an owner in time for draft day. If I cannot find someone prior to Saturday, I'll have to make arrangements to take care of that team's picks.

The money from those two former teams was divided evenly, to give each team a fair start. I have included 30-man protected lists for each of the two new franchises, as well as listing any player who was formerly owned by Poway and Santa Monica, but was not selected in the redraft. You can ignore the 30-man protected list of Santa Monica. That team does not exist anymore.

If this seems like an odd time to have such a major event take place, well, I agree. This was probably the most horrible time for me to have had to deal with a situation like this. Further, by excusing these two owners, I have lost my A.L. Reporter and Statistician. That should give you all some idea about how strongly I felt that this change was necessary. Although it inconvenienced me to no end, I felt it was absolutely imperative to do it now. I hope all of you have enough faith in me to know that I would not have done this if I wasn't 100% certain it was best for all of us. That is all I will say on the matter. (I would greatly appreciate volunteers for the two vacant positions)

Because a few of you sent 30-man lists to me, and one of you had a list lost en route to Jim, I had to produce a list to cover those teams. Also included are the protected lists of the two new teams.

### **LEAGUE DUES**

A few of you have expressed amazement that a league like this could run on only \$35 per person. Well, you were correct. We cannot--at least for this year. We did not have sufficient funds to get through our first season. I had to use some of the 1996 dues for that. I was hoping this would not be necessary, but it cannot be helped. When we originally made a budget for this league, a few matters were not planned into it. Most importantly, the League Directory published by Doug Kehlmeier. That took a significant piece of our funding, and was not included in the thought process (since it was a one-time deal) when the \$35 figure was finalized. In short, I must request an additional \$7.50 more from each of us. I'm not saying league dues won't be \$35 again next year, just that the \$35 **last year** was not enough. Although I encourage you all to send this in as soon as you can, it is not an emergency...yet. Just know that it will be needed in the next couple months. Thanks guys.

To review, you should all know that any non-amateur player who is not listed among the 30-man protected lists is eligible to be drafted. Any amateur not on a current BRASSball roster can be drafted.

## Manager Update

Manager Julio Machado was found dead outside his Puerto Rican home yesterday. Authorities wouldn't say what the cause of death was but speculation was that the hole in his head may have been partly to blame.

This is the second coach to have met with tragedy in the past year. Assassin pitching coach Mark Fidrych was gunned down in a promotional gimmick last June by a confused contestant.

Rumors have it that Assassin management is looking for an individual who might be less of a risk. Nearly \$25,000 was invested in background checks on the latest candidate (believed to have been Bo Diaz) who was scratched after questions about his status were brought to light (He died in a roofing accident 5 years ago).

Team owner Doug Campbell, at the request of his wife, had considered taking over the as the on field boss but the life span of an Assassin manager was too short. Reports are that she still is pushing the issue. Kind of makes you wonder about marriage and baseball and are they compatible.

The assassins went into the free agent market and spent a little too foolishly. Bobby Witt, Mark Carreon, and Jeff Branson were signed to rather large contracts especially for bit players. "We feel we have a chance at the division crown again this year and needed to get some of these guys in now," stated Campbell. "It will probably cripple us in the long run but we are playing

for today. We really do have a philosophy here in Nashville even though it may not look like it."

The team looks as if it will go with a platoon setup everywhere except for Jeff Conine and Chilli Davis Defense is a question this year but consultants to the team suggest this may not hurt the team as bad as the weak offense did last year. And although the defense is down, the offense has been upgraded considerably.
